S4A - Prohibition of advertisements referring to skill or service relating to the treatment/prevention/diagnosis of any disease/body condition without approval from the MAB

SCOPE OF CONTROL

- Private Hospitals
- Private Clinics
- Radiology Clinics
- Medical Laboratories

(operated by a registered medical practitioner having a valid annual practising certificate under the Medical Act 1971)

Advertising Guidelines for Healthcare Facilities & Services are intended to complement the provisions of the Medicines (Advertisement and Sale) Act 1956 (Revised 1983) and the Medicines Advertisements Board Regulations 1976

Para 1.4

Registered medical practitioners who wish to advertise their facilities or services should also abide by the 'Code of Professional Conduct' of the Malaysian Medical Council and related guidelines and directives issued by the Council.

Para 3.0 - Exemptions

Information circulated within the profession through medical journals and newsletters

- Calling cards, Letterheads, Rubberstamps and Signboards (clinic/road directional)
 - Should abide by the 'Guidelines on Dissemination of Information by the Medical Profession' (MMC)

Para 3.0 - Exemptions

- Seminar, Public Lecture, Public Forum Announcements
 - title / topic, date, venue, speaker's name and place of practice, speaker's picture (Passport size), and contact person/number for enquiries.
- Advertorials, Educational Articles, Community Health Messages
 - practitioner's name, registered field of practice and place of practice

Para 4.0 - Information which is Allowed

- Name & location
- Telephone number
- Hours of service
- Types of accommodation and facilities
 - E.g. Surgical, Maternity, A&E, Orthopedic
- Charges for the various services and facilities
- Photographs of practitioner(s) should not exceed 'Passport' size
- Name, qualification & field of specialty of practitioners.

Para 4.0 - Information which is Allowed

- Accreditation / Award Announcement, Congratulatory Message
 - Recognised certification received by the healthcare facility
 - e.g. ISO, hospital accreditation, national or international quality awards, initiative awards, etc
 - Congratulatory message on the occasion of opening / launching of a new wing / branch / department / discipline / healthcare facility / equipment.
- The validity period is one month from the date of approval of the advertisement.

Para 5.0 - Information which is Not Permitted

- Promotion of any individual practitioner's skills, knowledge and experience
- Comparison, either direct or implied between healthcare facilities
- The use of superlatives
 - e.g. 'the best', 'the first', 'latest', 'state-of-the-art', 'unique', 'most advanced', 'breakthrough' etc
- Display of Human Tissue Specimens and Photographs

Para 7.0 - Inducements to the Public

No financial inducements or benefits for treatment by way of sales promotions or discounts on professional fees shall be offered to the public.

3/2012 Advertisement on healthcare facilities and services in a medium which only features healthcare facilities and services without other general commodities on products or services on the internet website is allowed.

12/2007 (amended MAB 3/2011)

Use of celebrity in advertisement

MAB does not allow any advertisement which uses

- Patients receiving treatment
- Professionals (Doctors, Dentists, Pharmacists)

The use of a celebrity in an advertisement may be allowed upon the discretion of the MAB on a case by case basis where celebrity



- Local / International athlete
- Local / International model



7/2007 Medical Service Advertisements (Aesthetic Medicines)

The applicant is required to give a list of the registered medical practitioners involved and their full qualifications and training in the field of aesthetic medicine.

7/2004 Advertisement Application of Services From Other Country

The Medicines (Advertisement & Sale) Act 1956 requires the Annual Practicing Certificate (APC) issued by Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) for advertisement application of medical services. Therefore, at the moment any application from other countries will not be accepted and permitted to advertise in Malaysian publications.

7/2006 Request for amendments or changes to approved advertisement formats by MAB

- Requests for amendments must be submitted within 2 months from the date of approval by MAB. After 2 months the applicant has to send in a new application for approval
- Amendments are allowed once only
- All amendments must obtain approval from

MAB Decision

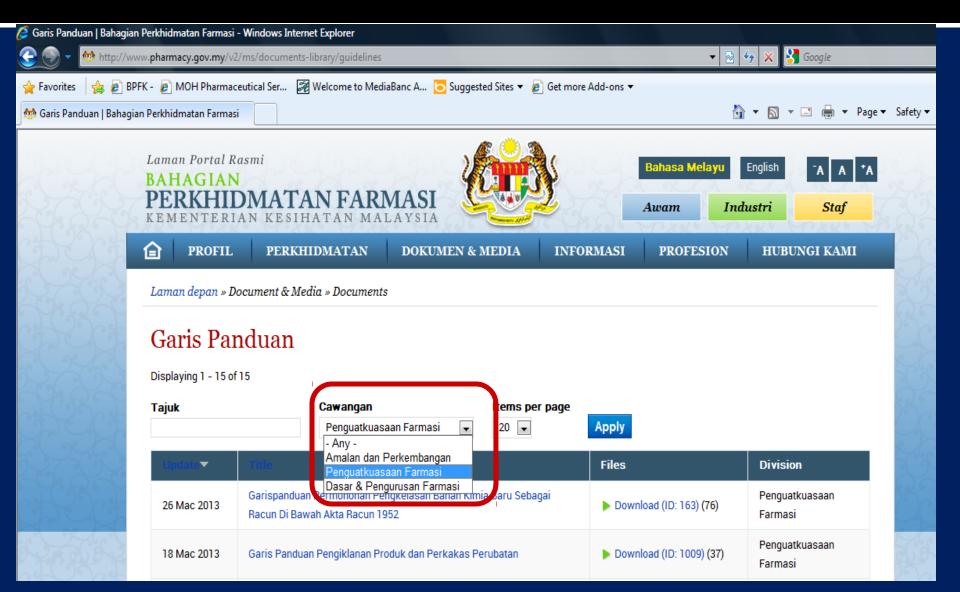
MAB 3/2012 (19 July 2012)

- The Board has decided not to allow links to social networking sites (e.g. Facebook, Twitter and Blog) in the advertisement of medical products and healthcare facilities and services.
- The MAB also agreed that the advertiser shall be liable for all of the information displayed in these social networks.
